12 Steps for Safe Sleep



Step 1: Back to Sleep for Every Sleep



Step 2: Use a Firm, Flat Safety-Approved Sleep Space



Step 3: Breast Milk Lowers the Risk of SUID



Step 4: Share Your Room, Not Your Bed



Step 5: Place Baby in Bare Crib



Step 6: Use a Pacifier to Reduce SUID Risk



Step 7: Avoid Smoking, Vaping, and Impairment



Step 8: Avoid Overheating and Swaddle Safely



Step 9: Keep Up With Doctor's Visits and Vaccines



Step 10: Research Baby Products Before Buying



Step 11: Practice Tummy Time



Step 12: Spread the Safe Sleep Message












HOW DO THESE EVENTS WORK?

They work to promote awareness of SUIDS and SIDS while training members for these workshops, becoming certified as Cribs for Kids ambassadors, and connecting with new hospitals for partnerships.




